- 3) **Wash Certificate Required: If previous load was any other type of animal products, by-products or last load was of a non-feed origin not listed in Part 2. If a PCS employee sends a driver to have their equipment washed, the driver must present their wash certificate (**signed and dated**) upon returning to confirm that the vehicle has been flushed clean with potable water before they will be loaded. (ex. but not limited to - poultry products, fish products, pork products, gelatin, sand, rock and other non-feed aggregate minerals)**

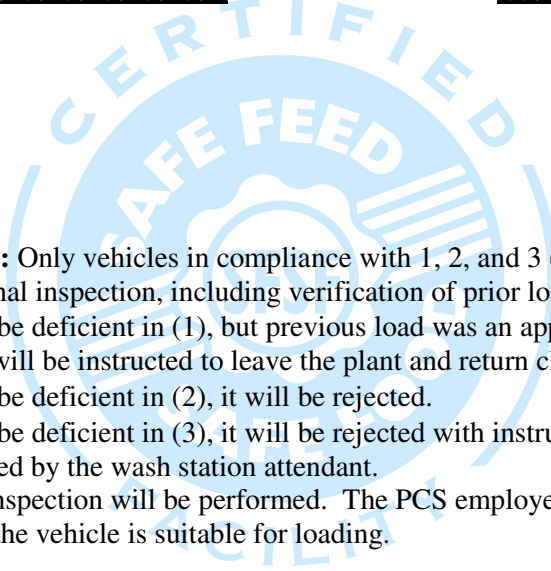

FINAL VISUAL INSPECTION: Only vehicles in compliance with 1, 2, and 3 (on other side) will be allowed to load. The vehicle will undergo final inspection, including verification of prior load, by a trained PCS employee.

- If the vehicle is found to be deficient in (1), but previous load was an approved feed material and not listed in (2) or (3), the vehicle will be instructed to leave the plant and return cleaned.
- If the vehicle is found to be deficient in (2), it will be rejected.
- If the vehicle is found to be deficient in (3), it will be rejected with instructions to return with a wash certificate signed and dated by the wash station attendant.

Upon returning, another visual inspection will be performed. The PCS employee loading the vehicle has the **FINAL** authority to determine if the vehicle is suitable for loading.
